**ACTIVITIES**

Throughout the week, campers will spend their days - **snorkeling** in local waters off of our USCG inspected 32' classroom boat in search of local species, participating in **hands-on labs** to study some of the world's smallest plants and animals we call **plankton**, observing bay life while **kayaking\*** over shallow seagrass beds, and collecting and studying the numerous Tampa Bay inhabitants with our **seine nets** and **otter trawl**.

*\*Kayaking is for Discovery and Ocean Expedition Camps only; weather-permitting.*

**REGISTRATION**

Registration will open for Tampa Bay Watch members on **Monday, March 5, 2018.**

All other camp participants will be able to register on **Monday, March 12, 2018.**

If trying to register multiple children (siblings, cousins, friends, etc.) in a camp week, be sure to do so at the same time for the best chance at having them together. We cannot guarantee multiple children can be registered in the same camp session.

Memberships must be current and at the seahorse level or above to receive the \$50.00 discount.

## CAMP DOCUMENTS

## LOCATION

All camps take place at the Tampa Bay Watch Marine and Education Center on Tierra Verde. This ideal location in the Shell Key Preserve boasts rich mangrove forests, grass flats and shallow waters teeming with marine life, and provides a perfect setting for our summer campers to engage in hands-on opportunities to learn about marine ecology and participate in service-learning projects.

## FACILITY

Our facility features an outdoor classroom complete with a fully equipped wet-lab and large aquarium tanks, while our indoor laboratory classroom is the perfect place to cool off and houses our lab equipment, interactive aquariums, and interpretive murals. Our classroom boat is a 32' Coast Guard certified catamaran that we use to transport students to exciting bay locations.

## STAFF & COUNSELORS

With degrees in biology, marine biology, and environmental sciences, our staff has numerous years of experience teaching students of all ages in both formal and informal field settings! They are onsite facilitating each day of camp throughout the summer and hold certifications in First Aid/CPR/AED. We are also fortunate to have college interns and junior counselors helping us with various sessions. All staff and counselors have gone through Level 2 background screening through the Division of Children and Families.

## MEALS

Campers in full-day sessions must pack a lunch each day. Campers in half-day sessions may want to pack light snacks. It is recommended that all campers pack light snacks that are easy to eat "on the go" for mid-morning and afternoon. We will provide some small snack foods as well.

If your camper has **dietary restrictions**, be sure to list these on the **CAMPER MEDICAL FORM** provided at registration so we can discuss any accommodations that may need to be made.

All Friday full-day camp sessions end with a lunch time **pizza party** provided by Tampa Bay Watch. If your child has any dietary restrictions, please ensure that they still pack a lunch for Friday.

**Nut-free** – Due to a significant increase in severe nut allergies Tampa Bay Watch will no longer allow items containing peanuts or tree nuts in camp. Please pack your camper's lunches and snacks accordingly. We greatly appreciate your help in keeping our campers safe and healthy.

Please label all gear to ensure it stays with your camper!

**REQUIRED:**

- Swimsuit and clothes that can get wet/dirty
- T-shirt to wear during water activities (all campers receive a Tampa Bay Watch Camp shirt)
- Lunch (Full-day campers only)
- Sunscreen (lotion, not spray on, and ocean-friendly is suggested)
- Water bottle (all campers receive a reusable Tampa Bay Watch water bottle!)
- Closed-toe water shoes or old tennis shoes (cinch-down or tie-down are best)
- Flip flops or crocs to change into
- Towel
- Change of clothes
- Snorkel gear (mask and snorkel, fins are not suitable for most of the snorkeling sites)

**SUGGESTED:**

- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Sunshirts/Rashguards
- Bug repellent
- Snacks
- Waterproof camera

**FOUL WEATHER**

We do our best to ensure that all planned activities are accomplished throughout the week, but safety is our first priority and the camp staff and captains reserve the right to change the daily schedule based on weather conditions (i.e. rain, high winds). Cancelled boating or kayaking trips will not warrant a refund. In the event of more extreme foul weather (i.e. tropical storm, hurricane, power outage, etc.) where a camp session cannot be completed, the schedule will be adjusted and refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

**CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY**

**No refunds** will be issued for: cancellations within 14 days of session start date, if camper does not show up for camp session, or if camper is dismissed from camp by camp staff for behavioral issues. Prior to 14 days before session start date, cancelled registrations will be assessed for a refund and a \$25 administrative fee will be applied if a refund is awarded.
