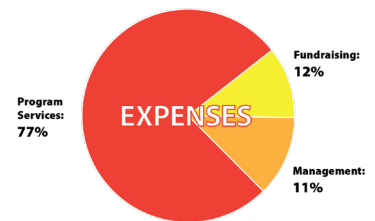
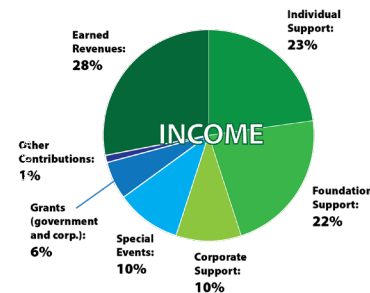

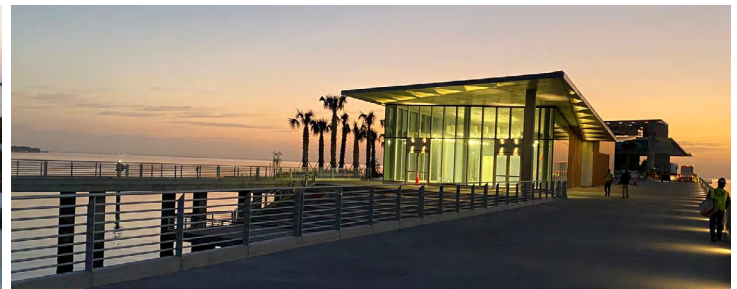


MARINE EDUCATION CENTER TIERRA VERDE, FLORIDA
